

Apprentice Lineman

The City of Monticello is seeking qualified candidates for an Apprentice Lineman. This position is responsible for performing diversified work of erection, repair, and operation of electric distribution facilities. Works on energized lines, structures, and equipment involved in the distribution of electricity. Locates sources of service interruptions and other troubles. The work often involves climbing poles and working out of a bucket truck with energized lines. Performs necessary construction, maintenance, or repair to restore services. Installs and maintains electric power lines, both overhead and underground.

Minimum:

High School diploma or equivalent is required

Completion of an approved lineman apprenticeship program or the ability to complete course within a reasonable time frame.

Valid Georgia Class A commercial driver's license. Must meet DOT certification requirements.

Reside within a reasonable response time distance to the office at 123 W. Washington Street, Monticello, GA 31064.

Ability to work overtime and be on an on-call rotation that will require work outside of regular business hours.
